Brief Report on the 45th PCA General Assembly

General Assembly is the annual gathering of our denomination to discuss matters important to the life of the church, make decisions that affect the whole denomination and the progress of the gospel. This includes conducting ecclesiastical (church) business, deciding significant theological issues, reviewing work of the denomination's ministries, and refining the Book of Church Order and our parliamentary procedures.

This year in Greensboro, NC, Dr. Alexander Jun was elected Moderator of GA; the first moderator from a racial minority in the PCA's history!

Besides the normal business and committee reports, the most time was spent on amending and ultimately approving the Report of the Ad Interim Committee on Role of Women. This committee was tasked last year to develop a report on the biblical role of women in the church.

Last year was a major milestone for racial reconciliation in the PCA. This year the Committee on Racial Reconciliation gave a follow-up report and was tasked to continue to develop ways in which the denomination can foster minority growth and health.

Reports on the local, national, and global impact of the PCA for the Kingdom of God were greatly encouraging. God is at work in this world, and is using our small denomination to reach and equip the world in Christ!
