1 We who are strong have an obligation to bear with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves. 2 Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up. 3 For Christ did not please himself, but as it is written, “The reproaches of those who reproached you fell on me.” 4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. 5 May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, 6 that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. 7 Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God. 8 For I tell you that Christ became a servant to the circumcised to show God’s truthfulness, in order to confirm the promises given to the patriarchs, 9 and in order that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy. As it is written, “Therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles, and sing to your name.” 10 And again it is said, “Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people.” 11 And again, “Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and let all the peoples extol him.” 12 And again Isaiah says, “The root of Jesse will come, even he who arises to rule the Gentiles; in him will the Gentiles hope.” 13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

The Apostle's Creed. Creeds are summary statements of belief, and have been used by Christians for centuries as a means of both learning and expressing their faith. The rationale behind the use of creeds is reflected in the words of G.K. Chesterton, once said "I will not call it [Christianity] my philosophy; for I did not make it...it made me.

The origins of the Apostle's Creed date back to around 200 A.D. The name "Apostle's Creed" does not indicate its authorship, but rather that it is a written summary of apostolic doctrine. It is the most universally recognized and read statement of faith in the Christian Church. For centuries Christians from many traditions have used this creed as a teaching outline, a guide for true doctrine, a summarization of the Christian faith, and an affirmation in worship.

Although The Apostle's Creed is ancient and widely used, Protestants have always placed this and other written creeds underneath the authority of the Bible itself, from which the historic creeds have been derived.

Among Western European and American Protestants a movement arose in the 19th century that discouraged the use of creeds or other written statements of faith. However the use of creeds is both historic and Biblical, with the Apostle's themselves often quoting from various creeds in their epistles to teach and encourage the churches.

God's people have used the Apostle's Creed and similar writings for centuries to publicly confess their faith as an act of worship. This morning we join our voices with the saints and martyrs who have gone before us, and whose lips and lives expressed the words of this creed.
